

NEWEST INSTALLMENT IN BDC GUEST LECTUR FEATUES UK PROFESSOR DR. THYNE

On February 2nd, Dr. Clayton Thyne, a Professor at the University of Kentucky, joined the BDC for the fourth installment in the BDC Guest Lecture series. This was Dr. Thyne's second appearance in the BDC Guest Lecture Series.

Dr. Thyne offered their subject matter expertise on the debate topic, "Resolved: On balance, Turkey's membership is beneficial to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization."

Dr. Thyne provided a presentation related to the topic, followed up with a Q+A where students were able to ask any questions. The Guest Lecture was hosted via Zoom and recorded for the public to view.

Lecture Key Points:

- Is Turkey's relationship with Russia is beneficial for NATO? Thyne described Turkey as "a thorn in Russia's side."
- Turkey owns the Black Sea, which stops Russian forces easy access to the Western European nations.
- Within NATO. Turkey has the third strongest military and the second most military personnel, making it a defensive asset against other nations outside NATO.

More recently, after the article was written, Aaron participated in the Winter Invitational on February 19th, and placed third with his partner Aryan Rana.




